It was because they had a firm grasp on the coming future. If you begin, all the while holding onto the future, you will surely have victory.</p> <p>1. These days, there are people who have no consideration for their future whatsoever, people who worry about the future, and people who make thorough preparations for their future.</p> <p>2. All other religions speak about hope in the end times, but the Bible prophesies of great suffering in the end times (Matthew 24, 2 Timothy 3). God Word tells us to come out from within that suffering.</p> <p>3. This kind of calamity and disaster befell the Israelites, as well (slavery, wilderness)</p> <p>4. My experience – Hardships continued to come as a result of the outbreak of the Korean War, idol worship in my family, and a fire that broke out in my town.</p> <p>5. The more important issue is what will happen to the future of the Israelites. ▶ Today, God is giving us the Word so that we can come out from within this.</p>	<p>◆ Introduction ▶ These days, there are more and more people who are suffering from spiritual problems that cause crimes that even the police find difficult to comprehend. At times, unforeseen problems may come before us. Then, in order for us to truly resolve this problem, there is an answer that we must all discover. This can be found in the phrase that Paul used most frequently—“in Christ.” Paul regarded all the blessings in Christ as the greatest blessing of all. ▶ Why did Paul use these words so often?</p> <p>◆ Main discourse 1. It is the name that changes our destiny. ▶ If we are in Christ, our destiny changes. That is why, starting today, we must restore our thanksgiving in faith. (1) Genesis 1:27, original man – lived happily together with God. (2) In Genesis 3, man was tempted by Satan to leave God and cannot return to God anymore. Man cannot find his way back to God through religion, morals and ethics, or good and charitable works. As a result of the futility of these efforts, he is bound for hell. (3) However, in Christ, our destiny is changed. 1) Romans 5:8, As a result of Christ dying upon the cross, He solved the Genesis 3 problem and opened up the way for us to meet with God. 2) John 1:12, those who receive Him – right to become children of God 3) John 5:24, crossed over from death to life. (4) What to be cautious of – Satan is still living. He tries to shake those who have received salvation. ▶ Starting today, find and enjoy the blessing of having your destiny changed in Christ.</p> <p>2. <p>Core msg: The Way to Find the Golden Fishing Ground (Acts 16:11-15)</p>	<p>◆ Main discourse 1. We must first know the spiritual things (cause) that we have lost hold of for so long.</p>	<p>1. Most lay leaders are losing the easiest and the most blessed thing. Even if you begin with a small concern for evangelism, God will work.</p>	<p>Regional Message: The evangelism schedule of the church lay leaders (Romans 16:17-20)</p>
<p>1. When the individuals truly enjoy the Gospel, everything will be resolved. That is when we can see the golden fishing ground. (1) Always enjoy your identity (Acts 1:12-14). (2) There is an important thing that must be discovered in the midst of everything. (Acts 1:1). (3) There is an important fact that allows us to be joyful even when facing death. (Acts 1:3). (4) There is a content that allows us to overcome even the most strongest things. (Acts 1:8). (5) They had something that could change the world (Acts 2:1-47). 1) 3 evidences (witnesses) 2) Golden fishing ground (Acts 2:9-47)</p> <p>2. Even when all doors are closed, we can see the golden fishing ground. (1) In the place where the way is blocked (Acts 16:6) (2) In the midst of not having anything (Acts 16:8) (3) In prayer (Acts 16:9) ※ They saw the golden fishing ground - Macedonia.</p> <p>3. We can see the golden fishing ground when meeting others (small meetings) (1) From Troas to Philippi (Acts 16:11-12) (2) Meeting Lydia by the river (Acts 16:13-14) (3) Doors for darakbang and the Regional Church opened (Acts 16:15)</p>	<p>(1) The Israelites who had lost hold of the Gospel ▶ God is not withholding answers from us. He wants us to restore everything through the Gospel and have complete victory. (2) These things are happening to them right now because they did not correctly receive the guidance of the Holy Spirit in the past (Joseph's brothers, 70 descendants) (3) God has called you as the priesthood so that you can save your family. This is the key to the exodus. God wants us to correctly realize the Gospel so that we can restore everything through the Gospel.</p> <p>2. At this time, we must correctly hold onto the blessings and the power that God gives to us. (1) We must believe in the power of God that was revealed during the exodus. (2) We must believe in the power of God that was revealed during the wilderness and prepare to enter into Canaan land. (3) Remember the answers that arose wherever the Ark of the Covenant went. (4) Build the tabernacle and live your lives centered on the tabernacle. (5) On top of that, He gave the commission of the priest.</p> <p>3. Burn incense day and night. (1) Burn the incense whenever you prepare the lamps. Burn the incense at twilight. (2) Keep the incense between the Holy Place and the Most Holy Place. Keep the incense burning.</p> <p>◆ Conclusion – always keep the incense burning (what we must enjoy starting now) ▶ What does it mean to keep the incense burning – This means to continue to pray (2 Corinthians 2:14-16, fragrance of Christ) 1. Return journey of the triumphant general – fragrance of life to the general and the fragrance of death for the captives 2. 2 Corinthians 2:16, fragrance of Christ – fragrance of death for the forces of darkness, and fragrance of life to save all others when we pray in the Gospel 3. Holy onto this covenant and pray. (1) Scheduled prayer – Keep the incense burning day and night. Everything will be solved. (2) 100-fold the blessings (Genesis 26:12, Mark 10:29-30)</p> <p>▶ I bless you in the name of Jesus that today, you may restore the fragrance of Christ. We are one body to establish the triumph of God. (2) Evangelist – blessing of the meeting with an evangelist (3) Blessing of meeting with disciples who understood evangelism</p> <p>◆ Conclusion 1. We must now run towards the greatest thing, do our best, and do what is most appropriate and fitting. 2. Illness, poverty, studies – Starting today, carry this into Christ. Then, just start praying a little bit. 3. Spiritual problems may come. 2 Corinthians 12, evidences will come if we enter into Christ and have complete enjoyment. ▶ I bless you in the name of Jesus that this may be the greatest week.</p>	<p>1. Most lay leaders are losing the easiest and the most blessed thing. Even if you begin with a small concern for evangelism, God will work. (1) Even if you see that your life has nothing to do with evangelism, God will open the door of answers (2 Co. 7:10). (2) If you start with your prayer concerning evangelism, the most fundamental door of prayer will begin to open. For the most part, however, people have other concerns and other prayers (Ac. 1:8, Mt. 24:14). (3) If you make the resolution regarding true evangelism when the door of evangelism is blocked, you will be led by the filling of the Holy Spirit (Ac. 13:1-4, Ac. 16:6-10).</p> <p>2. The miracles of God without falsehood: If lay leaders have evangelism schedules, surely this will take place (if you do not give up). (1) We are able to know this when we see that God entrusted Philippi to Lydia in Ac. 16:15, entrusted Thessalonica to Jason in Ac. 17:6, and Corinth to Priscilla and Aquila in Ac. 18:1-4. (2) God even entrusted a nation to lay leaders with evangelism schedules (Phm. 1:1-25, Ro. 16:23, Ac. 8:4-8, Ac. 8:26-40, Ac. 10:1-45). (3) God entrusted the world and the age to Paul who had an evangelism schedule (Ac. 9:15, Ac. 19:21, Ro. 15:23).</p> <p>3. People who have a true evangelism schedule enjoy the blessing that fits to the plan of God.
